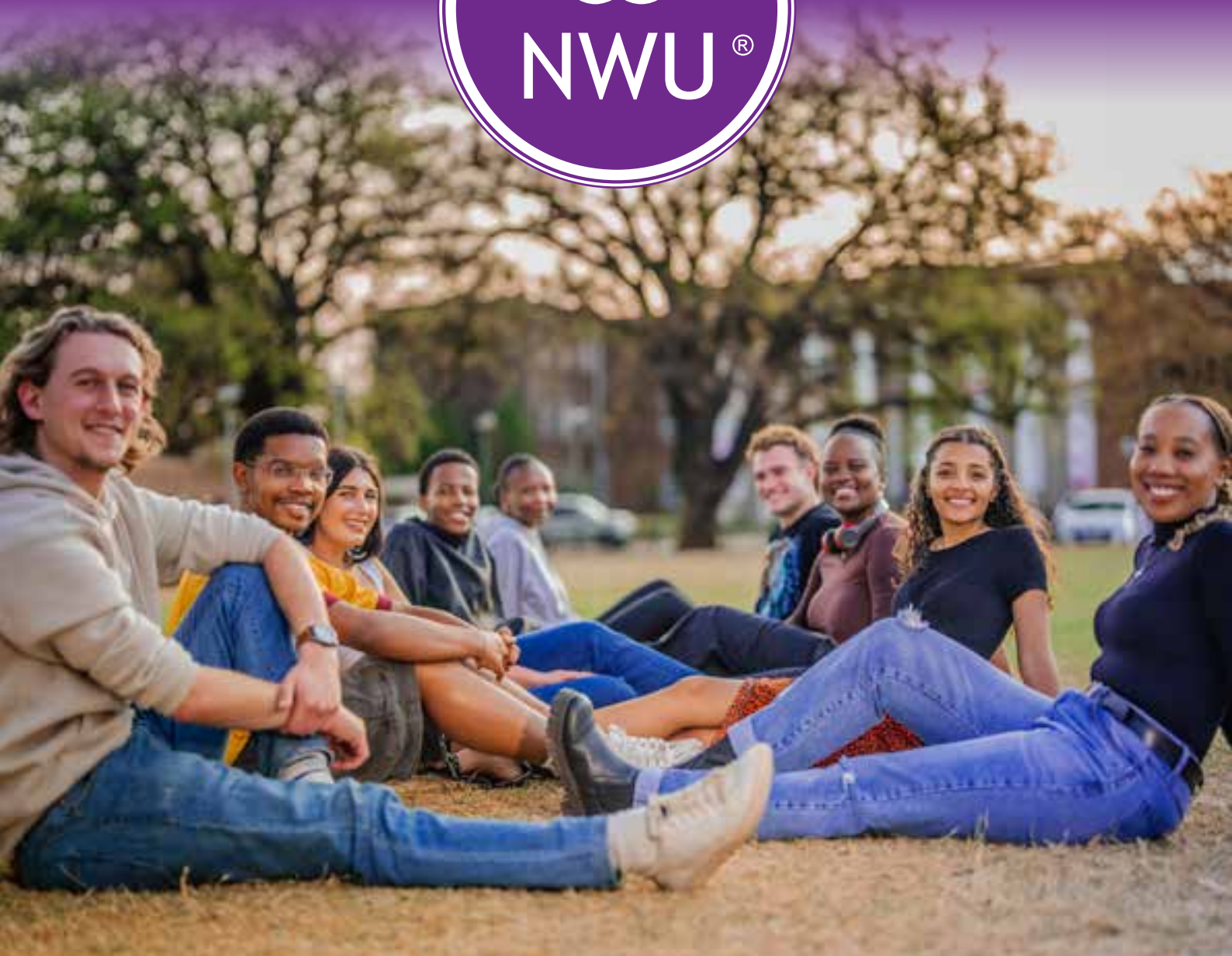

Minimum requirements: Bachelor's Degree

- Obtain a **National Senior Certificate (NSC)** or **International Secondary Certificate (ISC)**, issued by Umalusi, which also indicates that you meet the requirements for a bachelor's degree.
- An NSC with a minimum of 50% in any **four NSC 20-credit subjects**.
- APS is calculated using **six subjects**, excluding Life Orientation. Since Life Orientation isn't included at NWU, however most faculties at the NWU recommend a 60% pass in Life Orientation.
- **Subject-specific requirements** per faculty, which include the language of learning and teaching at 50%.

What is an APS?

The Admission Point Score (APS) helps universities assess if you meet the entry requirements for your chosen course. It's based on your Grade 11 or 12 results from your six best-performing subjects, excluding Life Orientation. Each subject earns points depending on your percentage.

The APS is a key factor in determining eligibility for specific programmes. NWU's APS Calculator allows you to calculate your score for NSC, International Secondary Certificate (ISC), and SACAI results, and check if you qualify for the programme you wish to apply to.

International Students

If you attended a private or international school, you may use the conversion table available on the NWU website to [calculate your APS score](#).

The Cambridge International curriculum is the most widely used international examination. Under this system:

Depending on which level you complete on the Cambridge system, you'll receive different scores.

- The **Cambridge IGCSE** qualification is equivalent to a South African Grade 11, and **Cambridge AS Levels** are equivalent to a South African Grade 12.
- Depending on the level you complete, you'll receive different APS scores.

APS Calculation by Level:

- **O/IGCSE Levels:** Begin at a score of 5 for the lowest level.
- **AS Levels:** Equivalent to the South African matric; grades above 90% earn an APS of 8, while grades of 80% and above earn 7, and so on.
- **A Levels:** Equivalent to a first-year university level; a grade of A earns the highest score, APS = 10.

Calculate your APS based on six (6) subjects, using the highest level passed in each subject.

Note:

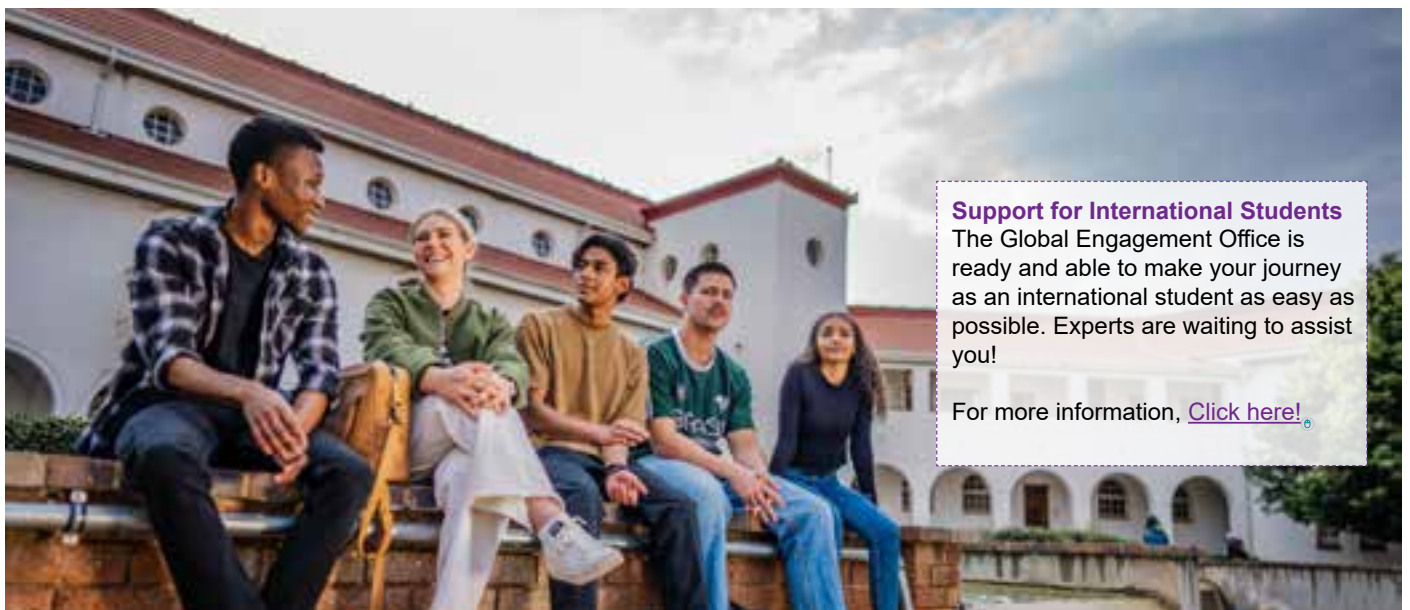
- For qualifications that require Physical Science as a subject, both Physics and Chemistry are mandatory.
- Mathematics is accepted at AS Levels.

Internal and External Bursaries

Studying takes hard work, but also requires funding. To help you finance your academic future, we have compiled a list of bursary schemes

Internal Bursaries

Academic Merit Bursary Own your academic journey and pay for your studies. The Academic Merit Bursary is available to all full-time first-, second-, third- and fourth-year students who complete their degree within its relevant duration, e.g., within three years for a three-year degree. To qualify for this bursary, you must meet specific academic requirements. Part-time students must apply and qualify for half of the allocation.

Family Discount Families with two or more students registered simultaneously at NWU can apply for this bursary and will receive a percentage discount on class fees, depending on whether you are the second, third, or fourth family member. One student must apply annually, and it is not awarded automatically.

Arts and Culture Bursary Students qualify based on their achievements in arts and culture from Grades 8-12. To apply, visit: [Arts and Culture Bursary](#). The Department of Arts and Culture will assess your application. Senior students qualify based on participation in cultural activities at university, e.g., NWU choir, symphony orchestra, and others.

Leadership Bursary Were you a head boy, head girl, or a chairman in Grade 12? Thanks to the once-off leadership bursary, you can get an additional discount on your first year of study.

Support Bursary NWU offers bursaries to prospective students with physical disabilities or students who come from an orphanage or foster care system. The relevant student must have university admission before applying and need only apply once. Ensure all necessary documents are attached to the application form: [Support Bursary Form](#).

Sports Bursary The NWU Sport Department only awards bursaries to contracted students. Prospective students with provincial colours can apply for a sports bursary in the year before they plan to study at NWU. For more information, [click here!](#)

1 Create Your Application Profile

- **Register:** Visit the [NWU application system](#) and create your profile by registering with your personal details as shown on your ID document.
- **Confirmation:** You'll receive your username (email address) and temporary password via email. Use these to log in to the application system.

2 Log In

- Use your username and password to access the application system. Be sure not to change your email address or phone number throughout the year, as all important communication will be sent to these contacts.

3 Choose Your Study Options

- Select up to two study programmes that interest you. For detailed information on qualifications, delivery methods, and curriculums, [visit our yearbooks](#).
- **Note:** Study options are linked to specific campuses. Ensure you choose the correct campus if your preferred programme is not listed.

4 Upload Supporting Documents

- Prepare and upload the following documents in a digital format (PDF, JPEG, etc.):
 - Certified copy of your ID document.
 - Final Grade 11 or 12 results.
 - If applicable, a copy of your academic records.
- **For International Students:**
 - Certified copy of your passport.
 - Most recent academic records and qualifications.
 - Medical examination according to your country's requirements.
 - Apply for an evaluation certificate from the South African Qualifications Authority (SAQA) after completing your high school career.

5 Submit Your Application

- Review all your information and read the declaration on the final screen before you submit it.

Owing to specific capacity constraints, the University reserves the right to select candidates for admission to certain study fields. This means that prospective students who comply with the minimum requirements will not automatically be admitted to the courses in question.

Because of the capacity limitations and the high demand for admission to particular fields of study, students will be evaluated based on their final Grade 11 results and fully accepted for admission based on their final Grade 12 results.
